Vouvray Brut Champalou NV Loire, France <i>This wonderful sparkling Chenin is clean, elegant and dry. A great aperitif wine that offers incredible value.</i>	9.5		48

Moulin de Gassac Classic Blanc Mas de Daumas Gassac 2021 Gassac, France <i>Unoaked Chardonnay, Viognier and Grenache Blanc from 25 year old vines. A pale lemon in colour. Dry and clean on the palate with a mineral backbone. An excellent all-rounder with food.</i>			41
Chenin d’ a Cote Pascal & Beatrice Lambert 2022 Loire, France <i>A quaffable Chenin blanc using grapes from Chinon. I love the Lambert wines; they are excellent, year on year. This is just what you expect from a chenin blanc: minerality, freshness, and lots of drinkability. Fruity notes on a background of minerality, white flowers, and spices, with a slightly nutty finish.</i>	9.5	38	48
Bourgogne Aligote Domaine Goisot 2018 Burgundy, France <i>Value is is an understatement at this world-class Domaine. Here we have a white Burgundy from Chablis (chardonnay) showing wonderful aromatic expressions of tree fruit like pears, citrus, and hawthorn, with a finish reminding hazelnuts.</i>	.		49
Fabbrica Bianco Fabbrica di San Martino 2021 Tuscany, Italy <i>The Fabbrica di San Martino was founded in 1735 in the hills outside of the town of Lucca in Tuscany. A blend of equal parts Trebbiano, Vermentino and Malvasia. A wine of gentle purity offering saline and herbaceous notes for those of you looking for a clean crisp white with adequate length and complexity.</i>	11	42	64
Chablis Cadette 2020 Burgundy, France <i>Chardonnay. A sensational white burgundy offering great balance between ripe notes and its fresh, crisp backbone. Unoaked.</i>			66
Pouilly Fuisse ‘Les Plessys’ Domaine Guillot-Broux 2019 Bourgogne, France <i>Chardonnay. Eleven months in oak barrels. This is your buttery, oaked Chardonnay; rich, soft, carressing and truly decadent.</i>			69
BB1 Lulu Vigneron 2019 Jura, France <i>Savignin & Chardonnay. Ludwig makes wines of elegance and purity and this is no exception. Made in the traditional “ouille “ style of Jura, it is slightly oxidative and textural, a complex web of white flowers and citrus with whiffs of pollen. This is a special one. Share with your best person.</i>			90

Amphora Bianco Guttarolo 2022 Puglia, Italy <i>A blend of mostly Verdeca from Cristiano’s vineyards, along with a little Chardonnay from an old organic vineyard in Gioia. A hazy shade of peach in the glass., wine with a gentle perfume of citrus and stones, and a mineral finish..</i>	10	40	60
Ad Naturam Blanc Chateau Lassolles 2019/20 Bordeaux, France <i>Sauvignon Gris & Sauvignon Blanc. The two vintages were brought together and aged 12 months before bottling. You get a sunny, complex orange wine that is perfectly balanced, with lovely freshness and delightful texture.</i>			60

Saint Cirice Chateau Saint Cyrgues 2020 Rhone, France <i>You could think of this as being interchangeable with a good red Côtes du Rhone. The terroir of the part of the Rhône Delta this comes from is not dissimilar. It's a blend led by Syrah and Grenache, offering lots of wine for the money.</i>			42
Suc de Saulo, Celler Comunica 2021 Montsant, Spain <i>Comunica Garnacha Carinyena is the estate wine of Mas d'en Cosme, made from roughly equal portions of Garnacha and Carinyena, and a touch of Syrah (10%). Comunica shows fresh blackberry, blackcurrant and raspberry flavours offset by an intense mineral line and incredibly smooth fruit tannins. Delicious!</i>			48
Audace, Mas Zenitude 2018 Languedoc, France <i>Cinsault. Harvested from 80 year old vines. Aged in terracotta eggs. Seven years offers a wine with some length and balance that is medium bodied.</i>	9.5	38	49
Fabbrica Rosso Fabbrica di San Martino 2018 Tuscany, Italy <i>This is as old-school as Sangiovese gets, with black cherry, balsamic and woody notes making for a soulful and soothing take on the grape. The 300 year old farm remains unchanged to this day and the vineyard that Beppe tends has never been exposed to chemicals and the resulting wines speak for themselves.</i>	11	44	66
Syrah, Stefano Amerighi 2018 Tuscany, Italy <i>A star of the Tuscan winemaking scene who only works with syrah and produces very small quantities. This is a wine of real precision and balance. Everyone should try an Amerighi syrah at some point!</i>			69
Langhe Nebbiolo Olek Bondonio 2021 Piemonte, Italy <i>Olek Bondonio has become one of the most sought after names in Barbaresco. His wines are pure and old fashioned in expression. Here we have a textbook example of the genre; neat tannins frame delicate flavours of earth and rose, making for a wine that over delivers in every way.</i>			72
Margaux Château Pavil de Luze 2013 Bordeaux, France <i>This excellent red is a blend of 75% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25% Merlot. An inky-purple in the glass. Scents of cassis, earth and sweet spices. On the palate, medium-bodied and balanced with ripe red fruit flavours and slight oak spice.</i>			74
GFX Olivier Boulin 2020 Jura, France <i>A fifty year old vineyard of Gamay planted over clay and limestone. Offering a wonderful marriage of grape and place, it pairs the variety's easygoing charm and perfume with the sort of texture and length one might expect from a great Pinot grown around here.</i>			76
La Stoppa Macchiona 2012 Emilia-Romagna, Italy <i>Barbera and Bonarda. La Stoppa are rightly considered one of the iconic Italian estates, and their top wine should rightly be considered one of the iconic Italian wines. So much going on here, all good things. Just hitting those early years of maturity, with earth-laden savouriness kicking into gear.</i>			82
La Myotte Domaine Guillot-Broux 2019 Bourgogne, France <i>Burgundian Pinot Noir of the finest calibre. Only bottled in the best vintages. Eleven months in oak barrels. A real treat!</i>			85
